Summary

Since 1993, Technopark Zürich has hosted ETH Zurich spin-offs and deep-tech firms — now around 300 companies and 2,800 jobs on one site — anchoring a spin-off pipeline of 43 new ETH companies in 2023, 93% of which survive past five years.
