

Technopark Zürich — Technology-Transfer Hub for ETH Spin-offs

Summary

Since 1993, this Zürich-West science park has co-located ETH Zurich spin-offs with established tech firms. It now hosts roughly 260 companies and 2,800 employees; a 2013 anniversary review found 58 of 285 resident firms were ETH spin-offs, with a 93% startup survival rate.
