Summary

Tunisia's first ICT technopark has hosted about 90 companies — including R&D; units of Microsoft, Ericsson and Alcatel-Lucent — employing over 2,900 people since 1997, but a peer-reviewed study found it was the sole success among ten Tunisian technoparks built in the same era.
