

The Caribbean Exam Board's 2026 AI U-Turn Reaches Dominica — CXC Permits, Then Redesigns, Assessment Around Generative AI

The Caribbean Examinations Council, which sets exams for Dominica and 20 other territories, will permit generative AI in CAPE/CSEC school-based assessment from 2026 and replace most SBAs with a supervised 'Paper 032' format by 2027-2028.
