

The EUROSAI Parallel Audit on AI — 12 Supreme Audit Institutions Benchmark Government AI Readiness

Summary

Coordinated by Israel's State Comptroller, 12 EUROSAI audit institutions applied a shared 9-topic, 92-question framework to benchmark government AI readiness, finding ownership ahead of operational guidance and ethics still principle-level, not tested assurance.
