Summary

Under OMB Memo M-24-10, US federal agencies (except DOD and intelligence) must inventory their AI use cases yearly and publish them; the 2025 inventory logged 3,611 use cases across 56 agencies — up 105% from 2024's 1,757 — with 445 flagged high-impact.
