

Third Oracle Academy Agreement Brings AI Curriculum to 220 Montenegrin Schools and Universities

Summary

Montenegro's education ministry signed a four-year renewal with Oracle Academy — its third since 2018 — giving about 220 schools and universities, 400 educators and 4,000 students free access to an AI, Java, SQL and cloud curriculum plus teacher training.
