Summary

A \$22.4M Green Climate Fund programme pays for agroforestry and forest rehabilitation across 25,440 ha of Haiti's Trois-Rivieres watershed, targeting 54,252 farmers and a 35% cut in flood-risk households; implemented by Haiti's Environment Ministry with UNDP as accredited entity.
