Summary

TÜB■TAK's 1513 programme funds Technology Transfer Offices in Turkish universities to commercialise patents and broker licensing deals. It gave 88.3M TL to 20 founding TTOs over five years, but TÜB■TAK's own 2024 review found most had low self-sufficiency.
