Summary

Kyrgyzstan's Estonia-modelled X-Road data layer grew from 363,000 exchanges in 2018 to about 3.5bn in 2024, linking 37 agencies and saving citizens an est. 21m hours and \$19m that year, per a 2026 Digital Public Goods Alliance case study.
