

UAE Ministry of Education — 'Safe and Responsible Use of AI in Classrooms 2026' Sets 25 National Prohibitions

The UAE's February 2026 classroom-AI guide bars generative AI for under-13s, forbids its use in formal exams, and bans uploading students' personal data to external AI services, naming ChatGPT, Copilot, Gemini and Claude as the only approved tools.
