

Ukraine's Center for Countering Disinformation Uses the Osavul AI Platform to Track Russian Information Operations

Summary

Ukraine's Center for Countering Disinformation uses the privately built Osavul AI platform to scan social media for Russian-linked disinformation campaigns, including fabricated videos, though metrics come mainly from the vendor and no independent accuracy audit exists.
