Summary

UNESCO and Gabon's Ministry of Education ran a 48-hour workshop training ~100 pedagogical inspectors in AI frameworks, prompt design and AI-integrated lesson planning (May 2025), with a follow-up course — while only 10% of Gabonese schools have AI governance rules.
