

# UNESCO x Technovation Idea Lab — AI Model-Building for Girls Across Pakistan

## Summary

A free, online 5-week UNESCO x Technovation programme taught 466 Pakistani girls (10-18) to build their own AI models addressing SDG problems such as food security and cyber-bullying, coordinated locally via the Karachi-based Pakistan Science Club.
