Summary

In March-April 2024, UNESCO and Antigua & Barbuda's Ministry of Education ran Youth Media & Information Literacy engagements reaching 338 stakeholders (46 youth, 3 disability orgs), training School for the Deaf educators; a regional follow-up extended the model in 2026.
