

UPNG's Campus-Wide AI Survey Sparks Curriculum Overhaul in Port Moresby

AI in Education · Good practice · Papua New Guinea

Quality score: 40/100

Evidence strength: Descriptive / self-reported

Summary

A 949-student UPNG survey ($\pm 5\%$ margin, $>99.9\%$ confidence) found 33% had used AI to write assignments and 96% wanted clear guidelines, prompting the university to launch AI-focused degrees and embed AI literacy across all programmes from 2027.
