

Use Facts: Disinformation-Resilience Training for Pensioners

Summary

Since 2022, North Macedonia's Institute of Communication Studies has partnered with the Pensioners' Union, funded by the British Embassy, to train 500+ retirees to spot disinformation. Trained pensioners scored 6-12% higher on identification tests than untrained peers.
