

Uzbekistan's Open Data Portal — From a 2015 Cabinet Resolution to a Top-50 World Ranking

Summary

Uzbekistan legally mandated open government data in 2015 and put its State Statistics Committee in charge in 2019. Independent Kun.uz reporting found its Open Data Inventory score jump from 19 to 63 in two years — the fastest climb of any country that cycle.
