

VARAM's 2024 Accessibility Audit — Zero of 132 Latvian Public-Sector Websites Fully Compliant

Summary

VARAM's 2022–2024 audit shortlisted 719 public-sector sites; expert review of 132 found none fully met all 11 accessibility criteria — 90% lacked image alt text and 88% failed the 'Papers' criterion — though sign-language non-compliance halved year on year.
