North Macedonia's first National AI Centre, 'Vezilka', launched in 2026 with a ~€6.2m budget (EU Horizon Europe/EuroHPC plus state co-financing) to give students, researchers and public bodies AI training and compute access, starting with a Macedonian-language model.
