

Vietnam's North Central Region Forest Carbon ERPA — FCPF Results-Based Payment

Summary

Vietnam earned US\$51.5M from the World Bank's Forest Carbon Partnership Facility for 10.3 million tonnes of verified forest-based emission reductions (2018-2019) across six North-Central provinces, with over 70% shared directly among 70,055 forest owners and 1,356 communities.
