

VioGén — Spain's gender-violence police risk assessment

Evidence strength: Observational / pre–post

Summary

VioGén scores the risk faced by gender-violence victims to set police protection — ~400,000 assessments a year, 6M+ in total. Powerful at scale, but documented misclassifications (low risk before some homicides) make it a cautionary case.
