Summary

World Bank-backed WACA ResIP paid local women and youth via AVOTODE to replant 283 ha of mangroves on Lake Boko-Zowla's degraded banks, restoring coastal buffers lost to firewood logging, part of a \$210M six-country coastal resilience investment.
