

WebThai2Access — Co-Tested Web Accessibility Checker for Thai-Language Sites

Summary

Thai and UK researchers built WebThai2Access, a 15-criterion WCAG-based checklist tool for Thai-language sites, then validated it against real user experience across 120 participants — 30 each of developers, hearing-impaired, visually impaired and elderly users.
