

With You Osaka — From an NPO Pilot to Japan's Institutionalised 24-Hour One-Stop Centre for Sexual Assault Survivors

Summary

Osaka's dedicated one-stop centre for sexual-violence survivors, opened October 2025, replaces the NPO-run SACHICO pilot (est. 2010) with a 24-hour, prefecture-run facility linked to ~40 hospitals — the culmination of Japan's 2011 push for one-stop centres in all 47 prefectures.
