Summary

WizdomCRM Caribbean and Trinidad's Catholic Education Board piloted an AI tutor app with eight animated characters across ten primary schools in 2024. Only 194 of 300 sponsored places were filled, and no independent results from the pilot itself had been published as of mid-2025.
