

YLLI — Albania's AI Virtual Assistant for Farmers, Newly Launched With No Usage Data Yet

Albania's Ministry of Agriculture launched YLLI, the country's first AI assistant for farmers, on its Farmer's Portal in June 2026, offering support-scheme guidance, market prices and sensor data in Albanian — though no usage or impact data has yet been published.
