Summary

A 38-million-dinar tender connected 94 underserved rural sectors across 15 governorates to 4G broadband, reaching roughly 180,000 Tunisians, 164 schools and 59 health centres — a state universal-service project completed in 2022 with no post-closure evaluation found.
